HOA dues are \$800.00 a year paid \$200.00 per quarter. The Tax Rate for Miralomas Homeowners is \$2.77 per \$100 valuation. This consists of the Boerne ISD Rate of \$1.354 per \$100 valuation, the Miralomas MUD rate of \$1.00 per \$100 valuation, the Kendall County Tax rate of \$0.4127 per \$100 valuation and the Cow Creek Groundwater District of \$0.005 per \$100 valuation. There is a transfer fee of \$245 a working capital fee of \$300 All fees and taxes are subject to change.
